Rep. Donnelson called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m..

MOTION: Rep. Bowman moved to approve the minutes of the February 5, 2008 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Aagard, Rep. Fowlke, Rep. Hutchings, Rep. Wiley, and Rep. Mathis absent for the vote.

1st Sub. H.B. 75 Inventory and Review of Commercial Activities (Rep. C. Frank)

MOTION: Rep. Oda moved to replace 1st Sub. H.B. 75 with **2nd Sub. H.B. 75**. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Aagard, Rep. Fowlke, Rep. Hutchings, Rep. Wiley, and Rep. Mathis absent for the vote.

Rep. Frank explained the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Bowman moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 5, Line 139:

139 (1) (a) There is created a Privatization Policy Board composed of {~~15~~} 16 members.

2. *Page 5, Lines 146 through 147:*
