Chair S. Clark called the meeting to order at 4:14 p.m.

MOTION: Rep. S. Clark moved to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2008 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Walker and Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.

S.B. 88 Uniform Model Registered Agent Act (*Sen. L. Hillyard*)

Sen. Hillyard introduced the bill to the committee with assistance of Garth Jacobsen, CT Corporation, Seattle Washington. (handout)

MOTION: Rep. Ferry moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Walker and Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.

1st Sub S.B. 79 Small Business Access Amendments (*Sen. R. Romero*)

Sen. Romero introduced the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Neuenschwander moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Walker and Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.

1st Sub S.B. 57 Franchise Law Amendments (Sen. D. Eastman)

Sen. Eastman introduced the bill to the committee with the assistance of Craig Bickmore, Utah Auto Dealers Association.

MOTION: Rep. Hansen moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. S. Clark moved to place 1st Sub S.B. 57 on the Consent Calendar with the approval of the sponsor. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Dunnigan absent for the vote.

S.B. 174 Dentist and Dental Hygienist Practice Act Amendments (Sen. P. Knudson)

Sen. Knudson introduced the bill to the committee with the assistance of Daniel Jones, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing.

S.B. 176 Unemployment Insurance Contribution Rates Amendments (Sen. H. Stephenson)

Sen. Stephenson introduced the bill to the committee with the assistance of Bill Starks, Utah Department of Workforce Services.

MOTION: Rep. Biskupski moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

H.B. 486 Wrongful Liens and Wrongful Judgement Liens (Rep. J. Gowans)

Rep. Hansen introduced the bill to the committee with the assistance of Chad Bennion, citizen.

MOTION: Rep. Ferry moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 3, Lines 60 through 62:

60 (1) (a) The provisions of Sections 38-9-1, 38-9-3, 38-9-4, and 38-9-6 apply to any
61 recording or filing or any rejected recording or filing of a lien or notice of interest pursuant
to
62 this chapter on or after May 5, {~~1997~~} 2008 .
