

**S.B. 189**  
**INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR DATABASE**

Senator **Dan R. Eastman** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 69 through 74:*

69           (1) (a) There is created within the department the Independent Contractor Enforcement  
70 Council consisting of the following ~~{three}~~ **four** members:  
71           (i) the executive director of the department or the executive director's designee;  
72           (ii) the executive director of the Department of Workforce Services or the executive  
73 director's designee; ~~{and}~~  
74           (iii) the commissioner of the Labor Commission or the commissioner's designee **;and**  
**(iv) the chief information officer of the Department of Technology Services** .

2. *Page 4, Lines 91 through 95:*

91           (b) beginning July 1, 2009, meet quarterly:  
92           (i) **with:**  
93 (A) ~~{with}~~ the attorney general or a designee of the attorney general; ~~{and}~~  
93 (B) the chair of the State Tax Commission or a designee of the chair; and  
**(C) the commissioner of the Department of Public Safety or the commissioner's designee; and**  
94 (ii) (A) to review the most recent results from the database; and  
95 (B) to coordinate regulatory and law enforcement efforts; and

3. *Page 4, Lines 110 through 114:*

110           (b) As part of the report required by this Subsection (3), the chairs of the Business and  
111 Labor Interim Committee shall provide an opportunity to the following to report to the  
112 Business Labor Interim Committee on the usefulness of the database:  
113           (i) each accessing agency; ~~{and}~~  
114           (ii) the attorney general **;and**  
**(iii) the Department of Public Safety** .

4. *Page 5, Lines 125 through 127:*

125           (1) (a) By no later than July 1, 2009, the department shall administer a database:  
126           (i) designed by the council to share data amongst accessing agencies ~~{and}~~ **;and** the attorney  
127 general **;and the Department of Public Safety** ; and
