LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies concurrent enrollment provisions.

AMENDS:

53A-17a-120.5, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2007, Chapter 368

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53A-17a-120.5** is amended to read:

53A-17a-120.5. Appropriation for concurrent enrollment.

(1) Money appropriated to the State Board of Education in Section 53A-17a-104 for concurrent enrollment shall be allocated as follows:

- (a) for courses that are taught by public school educators:



28 (i) 60% of the monies shall be allocated to local school boards and charter schools; and
29 (ii) 40% of the monies shall be allocated to the State Board of Regents; and

30 (b) for courses that are taught by college or university faculty:

31 (i) 40% of the monies shall be allocated to local school boards and charter schools; and

32 (ii) [40%] 60% of the monies shall be allocated to the State Board of Regents.

33 (2) The State Board of Education shall make rules providing that a school participating
34 in the concurrent enrollment programs offered under Section 53A-15-101 shall receive an
35 allocation from the monies described in Subsection (1)~~(a)~~ as provided in Section 53A-15-101.

36 (3) The State Board of Regents shall make rules providing that an institution of higher
37 education participating in the concurrent enrollment programs offered under Section
38 53A-15-101 shall receive an allocation from the monies described in Subsection (1)(b) as
39 provided in the rules.

40 (4) Each year the Legislature shall increase the money appropriated to the State Board
41 of Education in Section 53A-17a-104 for concurrent enrollment based on:

42 (a) enrollment growth in concurrent enrollment from additional students enrolled,
43 courses offered, and credit hours taken; and

44 (b) the percentage increase in the value of the weighted pupil unit.

45 (5) The State Board of Education and the State Board of Regents shall annually report
46 to the Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee:

47 (a) an accounting of the money appropriated for concurrent enrollment; and

48 (b) a justification of the split described in Subsections (1)(a) and (b).
