

28 (1) Subject to applicable rules of the Federal Communications Commission and
29 Section 53B-17-102, the State Board of Regents, the State Board of Education, and the
30 University of Utah, KUED - TV, KUER - FM, and UEN shall:

31 (a) coordinate statewide services of public radio and television;

32 (b) develop, maintain, and operate statewide distribution systems for KUED - TV,
33 KUER - FM, and KUEN, the statewide distance learning service, the educational data network,
34 connections to the Internet, and other telecommunications services appropriate for providing
35 video, audio, and data telecommunication services in support of public and higher education,
36 state government, and public libraries;

37 (c) support the delivery of these services to as many communities as may be
38 economically and technically feasible and lawfully permissible under the various operating
39 licenses;

40 (d) cooperate with state and local governmental and educational agencies and provide
41 leadership and consulting service for telecommunication for education;

42 (e) represent the state with privately owned telecommunications systems to gain access
43 to their networks for the delivery of programs and services sponsored or produced by public
44 and higher education;

45 (f) acquire, produce, coordinate, and distribute a variety of programs and services of an
46 educational, cultural, informative, and entertaining nature designed to promote the public
47 interest and welfare of the state;

48 (g) coordinate with the state system of higher education to acquire, produce, and
49 distribute broadcast and nonbroadcast college credit telecourses, teleconferences, and other
50 instructional and training services;

51 (h) coordinate with the State Board of Education and school districts to acquire,
52 produce, and distribute broadcast and nonbroadcast telecourses, teleconferences, and other
53 instructional and training services to the public schools;

54 (i) act as a clearing house for the materials, courses, publications, media, software, and
55 other applicable information related to the items addressed in Subsections (1) (g) and (h);

56 (j) coordinate with the State Board of Education to assist in providing the public
57 schools of Utah with the following services:

58 (i) broadcast, during school hours, of educational and administrative programs

59 recommended by the State Board of Education;

60 (ii) duplication and encoding of program masters for broadcast purposes; and

61 (iii) program previewing;

62 (k) share responsibility with the State Board of Education for Instructional Television

63 (ITV) awareness and utilization; and

64 (l) provide teleconference and training services for state and local governmental

65 agencies.

66 (2) UEN shall:

67 (a) consult with the UEN steering committee authorized in Section 53B-17-102 and

68 other technology coordinating committees established by the State Board of Education and

69 State Board of Regents in acquiring, producing, and distributing instructional content;

70 (b) coordinate the statewide development and implementation of the data network for

71 education, which shall include video and audio, data connections, and connection to the

72 Internet, utilizing satellite, microwave, fiber-optic, and other transmission media;

73 (c) utilize statewide economic development criteria in the design and implementation

74 of the educational telecommunications infrastructure; [~~and~~]

75 (d) assure that public service entities such as educators, public service providers, and

76 public broadcasters are provided access to the telecommunications infrastructures that are

77 developed in the state[-];

78 (e) provide statewide network infrastructure, connections to the Internet, and

79 interactive video conferencing services in support of public and higher education, state and

80 local government, and public libraries; and

81 (f) provide web services, distance learning, and professional development for public

82 and higher education.
