LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill prohibits the "Custody and Visitation for Persons Other than Parents Act" from being used to seek or obtain custody or visitation of a child that has been adopted.

This bill:

▶ prohibits the "Custody and Visitation for Persons Other than Parents Act" from being used to seek or obtain custody of, or visitation with, a child who has been relinquished for adoption, or adopted pursuant to an order of the juvenile court.
