Mr. Speaker:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 128**, ELECTRONIC PRESCRIBING ACT, by Representative R. Menlove, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 25:*

- 25 • ensure that electronic prescribing is done in a secure manner , consistent with industry standards ;

2. *Page 2, Lines 28 through 29:*

- 28 • grant a hardship exemption to a pharmacy or a practitioner , to the extent that the requirements of
- 29 this bill would impose an extreme financial hardship on the pharmacy or the practitioner .

3. *Page 2, Lines 32 through 33:*

- 32 Other Special Clauses:
- 33 {None} This bill takes effect on July 1, 2012.

4. *Page 5, Line 121:*

- 121 (b) electronic prescribing is conducted in a secure manner , consistent with industry standards ; and

5. *Page 5, Lines 124 through 127:*

- 124 (5) The division may, by rule, grant an exemption from the requirements of this section
- 125 to a pharmacy or a practitioner to the extent that the pharmacy or practitioner can establish, to the satisfaction of the division,
- 126 that compliance with the requirements of this section would impose an extreme financial
- 127 hardship on the pharmacy.
