## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

March 4, 2009

Mr. Speaker:

The Transportation Committee has returned **H.B. 161**, MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE FEE, by Representative L. Wiley, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 21 through 22:*

- 21           ▶ provides that a portion of the revenues from the fee shall be deposited into  
the Automated  
22 License Plate Recognition System Restricted Account; ~~{and}~~  
▶ provides that a portion of the revenues from the fee shall be deposited into  
the Transportation Fund; and

2. *Page 2, Lines 37 through 39:*

- 37           (1) As used in this section, "automated license plate recognition system" means a  
38 computerized camera system mounted on a vehicle ~~{or permanently mounted over a~~  
highway}  
39 that recognizes license plates to alert law enforcement of violations, including:

3. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 74:*

- 70           (2) ~~{All monies}~~ (a) An amount not to exceed \$800,000 of the revenues  
received by the state under this section shall be deposited into the  
71 Automated License Plate Recognition System Restricted Account created by Section  
72 41-1a-1223 for the purpose of providing funds to pay for any costs and expenses incurred
