H.B. 154 State Construction Registry Amendments (*Rep. M. Morley*)

Rep. Morley presented the bill to the committee with the assistance of Tom Harper, Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing.

MOTION: Rep. Dunnigan moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 10, Lines 301 through 306:

301 (4) The standardized building permit numbering system [~~developed~~] described under

303 ~~—(a) three alphabetical characters identifying the compliance agency issuing the~~
~~permit;~~

305 ~~—(b)}~~ a combination of alpha or numeric characters arranged in a format acceptable
to the
306 compliance agency.
