If this H.B. 32 and H.B. 11, Recodification of Natural Resources Provisions, both pass, it is the intent of the Legislature that the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel, in preparing the Utah Code database for publication, shall change Section 63-11-17.3, which is repealed and reenacted in this bill, so that the reenacted section reads:

"79-4-502. Violations of rules.

Unless otherwise provided in this title, a violation of any rule of the Board of Parks and Recreation is an infraction." ←H
