JUDICIARY AMENDMENTS

Senator **Lyle W. Hillyard** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 21, Lines 619 through 630:

619 Section 17. Section **78B-7-205** is amended to read:

620 78B-7-205. Service -- Income withholding -- Expiration.
