LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill removes one district court judge in the second judicial district and adds one juvenile court judge in the fifth judicial district.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ adds one juvenile court judge in the fifth judicial district; and
- ▶ removes one district court in the second judicial district.

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2010.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **78A-1-103** is amended to read:

78A-1-103. Number of district judges.

The number of district court judges shall be:



- 28 (1) four district judges in the First District;
- 29 (2) [~~14~~] 13 district judges in the Second District;
- 30 (3) 28 district judges in the Third District;
- 31 (4) 13 district judges in the Fourth District;
- 32 (5) five district judges in the Fifth District;
- 33 (6) two district judges in the Sixth District;
- 34 (7) three district judges in the Seventh District; and
- 35 (8) two district judges in the Eighth District.

36 Section 2. Section **78A-1-104** is amended to read:

37 **78A-1-104. Number of juvenile judges and jurisdictions.**

38 The number of juvenile court judges shall be:

- 39 (1) two juvenile judges in the First Juvenile District;
- 40 (2) six juvenile judges in the Second Juvenile District;
- 41 (3) 10 juvenile judges in the Third Juvenile District;
- 42 (4) four juvenile judges in the Fourth Juvenile District;
- 43 (5) [~~two~~] three juvenile judges in the Fifth Juvenile District;
- 44 (6) one juvenile judge in the Sixth Juvenile District;
- 45 (7) two juvenile judges in the Seventh Juvenile District; and
- 46 (8) one juvenile judge in the Eighth Juvenile District.
