The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 208**,
DISPOSITION OF THE REMAINS OF A DECEASED MILITARY SERVICE MEMBER, by Representative J.
Seelig, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 17:*
