1. *Page 1, Line 20*

► provides that a peace officer may not cite or arrest a person for violating the requirement to have evidence of owner's or operator's security for the vehicle in the person's immediate possession if the Uninsured Motorist Identification Database Program information indicates that the vehicle or driver is insured; and

2. *Page 4, Lines 90 through 92:*

90 (c) **(i)** Evidence of owner's or operator's security from the Uninsured Motorist
91 Identification Database Program described under Subsection (2)(b)(vi) supercedes any
92 evidence of owner's or operator's security described under Subsection (2)(b)(i)(D) or (E).

(ii) A peace officer may not cite or arrest a person for a violation of Subsection (2)(a) if the Uninsured Motorist Identification Database Program created under Title
