Mr. Speaker:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on S.B. 12, INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX CONTRIBUTION FOR METHAMPHETAMINE HOUSING RECONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION FUND, by Senator K. Mayne, with the following amendments and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page 1, Lines 23 through 25:
 - 23 enacts an individual income tax contribution for the Methamphetamine Housing
 - 24 Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Fund for a taxable year beginning on or after
 - 25 January 1, 2010, but beginning on or before December 31, {2011}
- 2. Page 7, Lines 189 through 195:
 - (1) For a taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2010, but beginning on or before
 - 190 <u>December 31</u>, {2011} <u>2012</u> <u>only, a resident or nonresident individual that files</u> an individual income
 - 191 tax return under this chapter may designate on the resident or nonresident individual's
 - individual income tax return a contribution as provided in this section to be:
 - (a) deposited into the Methamphetamine Housing Reconstruction and Rehabilitation
 - 194 Fund created in Section 9-4-1503; and
 - (b) expended for the purposes described in Section 9-4-1503.
