Rep. Ray called the meeting to order at 8:09 a.m.

MOTION: Rep. Vickers moved to approve the minutes of the February 2, 2009 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Daw and Rep. Sandstrom absent for the vote.

S.B. 21 Amendments to Social Worker Licensing (*Sen. D. C. Buttars*)

MOTION: Rep. Daw moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 3, Lines 72 through 73a

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously.

Sen Buttars explained the amended bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Daw moved to pass S.B. 21 as amended with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

S.C.R. 1 Alzheimer's and Dementia Awareness Concurrent Resolution (Sen. K. Morgan)

Sen. Morgan explained the resolution to the committee, assisted by Nick Zullo, Program Director, Alzheimer's Association of Utah.

MOTION: Rep. Beck moved to pass S.C.R. 1 with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 12 Individual Income Tax Contribution for Methamphetamine Housing Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Fund (Sen. K. Mayne)

MOTION: Rep. Vickers moved to amend the bill as follows:

2. *Page 1, Lines 23 through 25:*

23 ▶ enacts an individual income tax contribution for the Methamphetamine Housing
24 Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Fund for a taxable year beginning on or after
25 January 1, 2010, but beginning on or before December 31, ~~{2011}~~ 2012 ;

3. *Page 7, Lines 189 through 195:*

189 (1) For a taxable year beginning on or after January 1, 2010, but beginning on or
before
190 December 31, ~~{2011}~~ 2012 only, a resident or nonresident individual that files
an individual income
191 tax return under this chapter may designate on the resident or nonresident individual's
192 individual income tax return a contribution as provided in this section to be:
193 (a) deposited into the Methamphetamine Housing Reconstruction and Rehabilitation
194 Fund created in Section 9-4-1503; and
195 (b) expended for the purposes described in Section 9-4-1503.

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Daw absent for the vote.

Sen. Mayne explained the amended bill to the committee with the assistance of Jeffrey Fillmore, Chairman of the Board, Habitat for Humanity. (handout)

MOTION: Rep. Beck moved to pass S.B. 12 as amended with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Daw absent for the vote.

H.J.R. 5 Joint Resolution on Clean Air (*Rep. C. Moss*)

Rep. Moss explained the resolution to the committee, assisted by the 6th grade class of Morningside Elementary School and their teacher, Patti White. The students presented a program titled "Turn Your Key, Be Idle Free."
