Rep. Ray called the meeting to order at 4:20 p.m.

MOTION: Rep. Daw moved to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2010 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Riesen and Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

H.B. 379 Barber, Cosmetologist/barber, Esthetician, Electrologist, and Nail Technician Licensing Act Amendments (*Rep. M. Newbold*)

Rep. Newbold explained the bill to the committee.

MOTION: Rep. Ray moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 12, Lines 348 through 353:

348 (iv) (A) having graduated from a recognized ~~master~~ esthetics school {~~or a~~
recognized
349 cosmetology/barber school} located in a state other than Utah whose curriculum
consists of less
350 than 1,200 hours of instruction, with full flexibility within the 1,200 hours or the
equivalent
351 number of credit hours; and
352 (B) having practiced as a licensed ~~master~~ esthetician for a period of not less than
4,000 hours;

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

Rep. Daw moved to pass H.B. 379 as amended with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

H.B. 170 Foster Care Revisions (*Rep. K. Gibson*)

Rep. Gibson explained the bill to the committee.

Rep. Daw assumed the chair.

The original motion to pass H.B. 170 with a favorable recommendation passed with Rep. Beck voting in opposition to the motion and Rep. Sandstrom absent for the vote.

Rep. Vickers assumed the chair.

H.B. 331S1 Waste Fee and Related Amendments (*Rep. R. Menlove*)

MOTION: Rep. Riesen moved to adopt 2nd Substitute H.B. 331. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Beck, Rep. Sandstrom, and Rep. Ray absent for the vote.
