Rep. McIff called the meeting to order at 8:02 a.m.

**H.B. 396 Speech-language Pathology and Audiology Licensing Act Amendments
(Rep. D. Ipson)**

MOTION: Rep. Herrod moved to replace H.B.396 with 1st Substitute H.B.396.
The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Litvack and Rep. Sumsion absent
for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Mascaro moved to amend 1st Substitute H.B.396 as follows:

1. Page 3, Lines 72 through 74:

- 72 (b) provide the committee with verification that the applicant has received at least a
73 master's degree in the area of audiology from an accredited university or college, based on
a
74 program of studies primarily in the field of audiology **, and holds the CCC or its full**
equivalent .

The motion to amend the bill passed unanimously with Rep. Litvack and
Rep. Sumsion absent for the vote.

99 clinical doctorate degree in audiology {s} or AuD, after June 30, 2010; and
