REVENUE BOND AND CAPITAL FACILITIES AUTHORIZATIONS

Representative **Stephen D. Clark** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 17 through 18:*

▶ provides that authorizations for projects to be funded from agency, institutional, or donated funds does not prohibit a future request to use state funds for capital improvements on the project, subject to legislative approval; and
