HEALTH SYSTEM AMENDMENTS

Senator **J. Stuart Adams** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 16 through 17:*

(4) (a) A resident of this state may not be required to obtain or maintain health insurance as defined in Section 31A-1-301, regardless of whether the individual has or is eligible for health insurance coverage under any policy or program provided by or through the individual's employer or a plan sponsored by the state or federal government.

(b) The provisions of this title may not be used to hold a resident of this state liable for any penalty, assessment, fee, or fine as a result of the individual's failure to procure or obtain health insurance coverage.

(c) This section does not apply to an individual who voluntarily applies for coverage under a state administered program pursuant to Title XIX or Title XXI of the Social Security Act.
