- 2. Page 4, Line 107:
 - 107 (ii) last significant seismic related improvement;
- 3. Page 4, Line 110:
 - 110 (e) a copy of any structural or seismic evaluation { conducted } or summary of seismic or structural evaluations completed .
- 4. Page 4, Line 111:
 - 111 (2) As funding { allocated by the Public School Seismic Safety Committee } appropriated to the State Board of Education allows, each
- 5. *Page 4, Lines 113 through 114:*
 - (a) conduct a seismic safety rapid visual screening of each facility used by the school
 - 114 <u>district or charter school</u> <u>that has not been evaluated</u> in accordance with federal guidelines <u>or a more</u> <u>detailed seismic structural evaluation</u> ;
- 6. Page 5, Lines 128 through 143:
 - 128 (5) {(a)} The State Board of Education shall reimburse school districts and charter
 - schools for the costs of complying with this section from funds appropriated for that purpose.
 - 130 { (b) If reimbursement requests from school districts and charter schools exceed
 - 131 available funds, the State Board of Education shall proportionately reduce the allocation for
 - 132 each reimbursement request to match the level of available funds.
