

# 1st Sub. S.B. 51

## BIOPROSPECTING

Senator **Lyle W. Hillyard** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 46:*

45 (ii) information concerning a naturally occurring microorganism's, plant's, or  
46 ~~{fungus's}~~ fungus'  
46 physical or genetic properties.

2. *Page 3, Lines 65 through 67:*

65 (1) This chapter does not modify or replace any other requirement under federal, state    
66 or local law related to an act that under this chapter is considered bioprospecting, including any  
67 requirement to obtain the permission of a landowner.

3. *Page 3, Lines 76 through 77:*

76 (1) (a) On and after July 1, 2011, before engaging in an act of bioprospecting   a person  
77 shall register with the division.

4. *Page 3, Lines 83 through 84:*

83 (3) The division shall create, by rule made in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah  
84 Administrative Rulemaking Act, a registration form for purposes of this chapter that includes:

5. *Page 4, Lines 96 through 97:*

96 (a) the act of ~~{bioprospecting}~~ bioprospecting ;  
97 (b) a microorganism, plant, or ~~{fungi}~~ fungus removed from a natural environment in the state;

6. *Page 4, Lines 110 through 112:*

110 (2) If found guilty of a violation under this chapter, a court may in addition to a penalty  
111 imposed under Section 76-6-206  order restitution that is proportional to the economic interests  
112 the state may have under Section 65A-14-202.
