Senator **Wayne L. Niederhauser** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 14 through 16:*

14 ▶ provides that if owner's or operator's security is in effect in certain amounts, the
15 owner of the motor vehicle or the person who gave or furnished the motor vehicle to
16 the minor is {~~not~~} subject to the joint and several liability imposed but not to exceed a certain
amount ;

2. *Page 2, Lines 33 through 40:*

33 (1) (a) {~~The~~} Subject to the provisions of Subsection (1)(b), the owner of a motor vehicle
causing or knowingly permitting a person younger
34 than 18 years of age to drive the motor vehicle on a highway, or a person who gives or
35 furnishes a motor vehicle to the minor, are each jointly and severally liable with the minor for
36 any damages caused by the negligence of the minor in driving the motor vehicle.
37 (b) If owner's or operator's security covering the minor's operation of the motor vehicle
38 is in effect in amounts as required under Section 31A-22-304, the owner of the motor vehicle
39 or the person who gave or furnished the motor vehicle to the minor under Subsection (1) (a) is {not
40 subject to the liability imposed under Subsection (1).} subject to the liability imposed under
Subsection (1)(a) but not to exceed \$100,000.
