LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies Title 30, Husband and Wife, by enacting language relating to the family.

This bill:

► states, as the public policy of Utah, that a traditional family, consisting of a legally and lawfully married man and woman and their children, is the fundamental unit of society.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **30-1-4.2** is enacted to read:



26 **30-1-4.2. Public policy in support of family.**

27 (1) The traditional family, consisting of the legal union of a man and a woman and
28 children conceived and born to, or adopted by, the married couple as father and mother, is the
29 fundamental unit of society.

30 (2) The laws of the state shall, to the fullest extent possible, strengthen, safeguard, and
31 protect traditional families.
