31	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
32	Section 1. Section 58-37-6.5 is enacted to read:
33	<u>58-37-6.5.</u> Continuing professional education for controlled substance prescribers.
34	(1) Beginning on July 1, 2012, each individual, other than a veterinarian, who has a
35	license to prescribe a controlled substance under Title 58, Chapter 37, Utah Controlled
36	Substances Act, shall complete at least four continuing professional education hours in
37	approved controlled substance classes per licensing period.
38	(b) Any controlled substance prescribing class under this section shall:
39	(i) qualify for the AMA PRA Category 1 Credit;
40	(ii) be presented by an organization accredited to provide continuing medical education
41	<u>by:</u>
42	(A) the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education;
43	(B) the Utah Medical Association; or
44	(C) another recognized state continuing medical education accrediting body; and
45	(iii) be approved by:
46	(A) the recognized state continuing medical education accrediting body; and
47	(B) the division.
48	(2) The division, by rule and in consultation with the applicable practitioner licensing
49	board and the recognized state continuing medical education accrediting body, shall establish
50	educational content for any controlled substance prescribing class under this section. The
51	content shall include:
52	(a) the scope of controlled substance prescribing problem;
53	(b) abuse, dependence, and addictive properties and toxicity of controlled substances;
54	(c) use of state controlled substance database;
55	(d) specific pharmacology;
56	(e) screening for risk;

57	(f) monitoring compliance;
58	(g) prevention strategies;
59	(h) early and late interventions and treatment;
60	(i) state controlled substances guidelines; and
61	(j) patient education on controlled substances, such as opioid analgesics,
62	sedative/hypnotic depressants, and psychostimulants, and dangers and appropriate uses of
63	controlled substances.
64	(3) A controlled substance prescribing class required under this section:
65	(a) may be held:
66	(i) in conjunction with other continuing medical education programs; and
67	(ii) online;
68	(b) does not increase the total number of states required continuing medical education
69	hours required for a prescriber; and
70	(c) shall be reported by an individual as part of the continuing medical education
71	required for licensing.
72	(3) The division may establish rules, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
73	Administrative Rulemaking Act, to implement this section.
