Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section 17-25-6 is enacted to read:

17-25-6. ~~Uniforms.~~

~~(1) A constable;~~ **Identification of constables.**

~~(i) while;~~ **While** performing a duty described in Section 17-25-1, ~~{wear a uniform shirt in accordance with Subsection (2); and~~

~~(ii) purchase the uniform shirt; and~~

~~(b) may not use county or municipal funds to purchase the uniform shirt.~~

~~(2) (a) The legislative body of the appointing county or municipality described in Section 17-25a-1 shall designate the uniform shirt described in Subsection (1)(a)(i); and~~

~~(b) the uniform shirt shall clearly identify:~~

~~(i) a constable shall prominently display a badge or other visible form of credentials and identification identifying:~~

~~(1) a person as a constable;~~

~~(2) the person's name; and~~
