Madam Speaker:

The Revenue and Taxation Committee recommends **H.B. 138**, FEDERAL RECEIPTS REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, by Representative K. Ivory, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 138**, FEDERAL RECEIPTS REPORTING REQUIREMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. *Page 3, Lines 75 through 80:*
 - higher education listed in Section 53B-2-101.
 - 76 (b) The report required by Subsection (2) that the State Office of Education prepares
 - shall include the information required by Subsections (2)(a) through (c) for each school district and each charter school within
 - 78 <u>the public education system.</u>
 - 79 (4) A designated state agency that prepares a report in accordance with Subsection (2)
 - 80 shall submit the report to the Division of Finance on or before November 1 of each year.
- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 20:
 - 11 receipts are reduced by {-25% or more} certain amounts, and requires the Government Operations and
 - 12 Political Subdivisions Interim Committee to study whether to apply federal receipts
 - 13 reporting requirements to certain other governmental entities.
 - 14 Highlighted Provisions:
 - 15 This bill:
 - 16 ▶ defines terms;
 - 17 requires certain state agencies to prepare and submit a report to the Division of
 - 18 Finance on federal receipts received by the state agencies;
 - requires the report to contain a plan to operate the state agency in the event federal
 - 20 receipts are reduced by {25% or more} certain amounts;







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- 2. *Page 3, Lines 71 through 75:*
 - 71 (d) { develops a plan } develop plans for operating the designated state agency if there is a reduction of 5%, and a reduction of
 - 72 25% or more in the federal receipts that the designated state agency receives.
 - 73 (3) (a) The report required by Subsection (2) that the Board of Regents prepares shall
 - 74 <u>include the information required by Subsections (2)(a) through (c) for each state institution</u> of
 - 75 <u>higher education listed in Section 53B-2-101.</u>
