Approval of Minutes

MOTION: Sen. Liljenquist moved to approve minutes of the February 10, 2011, meeting.

The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Urquhart and Davis absent for the vote.

1. **S.B. 191 Workers' Compensation Coverage Waivers** (*K. Mayne*)

Sen. Mayne explained the bill assisted by Dennis Lloyd, Senior Vice President, Workers' Compensation Fund who also answered questions from the committee.

Alan Hennebold, Deputy Commissioner, Utah Labor Commission further clarified the bill and answered questions from the committee.

MOTION: Sen. Davis moved to transmit S.B. 191 with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Urquhart absent for the vote.

2. **H.B. 196 Continuing Education Requirements for Landscape Architects** (*R.C. Webb*)

Rep. Webb explained the bill assisted by Jay Nielsen, American Society of Landscape Architects.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to transmit H.B. 196 with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Urquart absent for the vote.

3. **H.B. 237 Enforcement of Liens** (*Julie Fisher*)

Rep Fisher explained the bill assisted by Brad Simpson, Director, Division of Motor Vehicles both of whom answered questions from the committee.

The following amendment was proposed:

1. *Page 2, Lines 33 through 37:*

- 33 occupant~~[, and a]~~. If the property to be sold in an enforcement action includes a motor
34 vessel, or outboard motor, the notice shall also be delivered to the last known address of
35 registered owner **and any lienholder** , as disclosed by the records of the Motor Vehicle
36 Division. A copy of the
37 notice shall, at the same time, be sent to the sheriff of the county where the self-service
storage
facility is located. Any lienholder with an interest in the property to be sold or otherwise
