Chair Reid called the meeting to order at 2:15 p.m.

**MOTION:** Sen. Stevenson moved to approve minutes of the January 31, 2011, meeting.

The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Okerlund and Jones absent for the vote.

1. **S.B. 134 Transparency in Health Care Provider Advertising** (*J. Stevenson*)

Sen. Stevenson explained the bill assisted by Casey Hill, Utah Medical Association, both of whom answered questions from the committee.

Aleta Taylor, South Jordan Community Council, spoke in support of the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Okerlund moved to transmit S.B. 134 with a favorable recommendation.

2. **S.C.R. 6 Concurrent Resolution Honoring the Sorsenson Legacy Foundation**  
(*C. Bramble*)

Sen. Bramble explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Morgan moved to transmit S.C.R. 6 with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Jones absent for the vote.

3. **S.C.R. 9 Philo T. Farnsworth Concurrent Resolution** (*D. Stowell*)

Sen. Stowell distributed the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 22 through 23:*

22 WHEREAS, Philo T. Farnsworth has deep roots in Beaver, Utah, where he was born
