Representative **Kay L. McIff** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 9, Lines 263 through 268:*

263 (5) (a) (i) ~~{Candidates}~~ Except as provided by Subsection (5)(b), a candidate receiving  
the highest number of votes cast for each office at the  
264 regular primary election ~~{are}~~ is nominated by ~~{their}~~ the candidate's party or nonpartisan  
group for that office.

(ii) Except as provided by Subsection (5)(b), the two candidates for a nonpartisan office who receive the highest number of votes advance to the regular general election.

265 (b) If two or more candidates are to be elected to the office at the regular general  
266 election ~~{,}~~ :

(i) those party candidates equal in number to positions to be filled who receive the  
267 highest number of votes at the regular primary election are the nominees of their party for those  
268 positions ~~{,}~~ ; and

(ii) the candidates for nonpartisan office double in number to positions to be filled who receive the highest number of votes at the regular primary election advance to the regular general election.
