

Senator **Howard A. Stephenson** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 20 through 21:

20 the use of the previous year's mission based funding;

► requires an institution that receives an allocation of mission based funding to provide a student with certain information regarding the student's educational field of study and occupational outlook;

21 ► requires the president of each institution of higher education to:

(i) major, minor, or pre-major, chosen by a student in conjunction with the student's pursuit of a degree; or

(ii) course of study chosen by a student in conjunction with the student's pursuit of a certificate.

(b) An institution that receives an allocation of mission based funding described in Subsection (2), shall provide a student who chooses an educational field of study with the following information:

(i) the number of students statewide at a higher education institution listed in Subsection 53B-2-101(1) in the student's educational field of study during the prior year;

(ii) the average completion rate of a student in the student's educational field of study from a higher education institution listed in Subsection 53B-2-101(1) ;

(iii) the percentage of people who graduate from a higher education institution listed in Subsection 53B-2-101(1) with a degree or certificate in the student's educational field of study who enroll in a post-graduate program;

(iv) the percentage of people who graduate from a higher education institution listed in Subsection 53B-2-101(1) with a degree or certificate in the student's educational field of study who obtain employment within nine months of graduating with the degree or certificate; and

(v) occupational data for a person completing the student's educational field of study as reported by the Department of Workforce Services.
