LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill creates the Veterans Reintegration Task Force.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ creates the Veterans Reintegration Task Force composed of 15 members;
- ▶ requires the task force to study difficulties encountered by returning service members after deployments and create a statewide action plan for assisting with reintegration into communities;
- ▶ charges the task force with creating a statewide action plan for collaborating, assisting, and coordinating with reintegration into communities; and
- ▶ requires that the task force report to the Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Interim Committee.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates in fiscal year 2011-12:

- ▶ To the Senate, as a one-time appropriation:
 - from the General Fund ~~\$→ [\$6,000]~~ \$4,000 ~~←\$~~ to pay for the Veterans Reintegration Task Force;
- and
- ▶ To the House of Representatives, as a one-time appropriation:
 - from the General Fund ~~\$→ [\$9,000]~~ \$6,000 ~~←\$~~ to pay for the Veterans Reintegration Task Force.

Other Special Clauses:

H.B. 162



90 following sums of money are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or
91 reduced from amounts previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated for the
92 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012. These are additions to any
93 amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2012.
