32	(1) If the state obtains matching funds of equal sums from private contributors, the
33	board may award grants to institutions of higher education or nonprofit educational
34	organizations for programs that provide mentoring and training leading to a secondary
35	education license with an endorsement in mathematics for an individual who:
36	(a) is not a teacher in a public or private school;
37	(b) does not have a teaching license;
38	(c) has a bachelor's degree or higher; and
39	(d) demonstrates a high level of mathematics competency by:
40	(i) successfully completing substantial course work in mathematics; and
41	(ii) passing a mathematics content exam.
