10-7-6, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section 10-7-6 is amended to read:

10-7-6. Contracts for lighting public buildings, streets, and alleys.

The board of commissioners, city council, or the board of trustees may enter into a contract on behalf of the city or town for the lighting of its public buildings, streets, alleys, and other public places for [such] a period of time [as such] that the board of commissioners, city

30 council, or board of trustees may [~~deem~~] consider advisable[, ~~not to exceed three years~~].
