Mr. President:

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 43**, BARBER, COSMETOLOGIST, ESTHETICIAN, ELECTROLOGIST, AND NAIL TECHNICIAN ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. Dunnigan, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 67 through 72:*

67           (11) a person who:

(a) is qualified to engage in the practice of barbering, cosmetology/barbering, esthetics, master-level esthetics, electrology, or nail technology in another jurisdiction as evidenced by licensure, certification, or lawful practice in the other jurisdiction;

68           ~~{(a)}~~ (b) is employed by, or under contract with, a motion picture company;  
and

69           ~~{(b)}~~ (c) engages in the practice of barbering, cosmetology/barbering.
