The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 80**, REORGANIZATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT FUNCTIONS IN STATE AGENCIES, by Representative W. Harper, with the following amendments:
