Madam Speaker:

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 230**, UTAH SCHOOLS FOR THE DEAF AND THE BLIND AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. Seelig, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 18 through 19:
 - report <u>verbally and in written form</u> annually to the Education Interim

 Committee on the Utah Schools for the
 - 19 Deaf and the Blind;
- 2. Page 3, Lines 64 through 89:
 - 64 $[\frac{(3)(a)}{(a)}]$ (4) (a) The board shall:
 - 65 [(i) appoint members of the Advisory Council for the Utah Schools for the Deaf and
 - 66 the Blind; and
 - 67 [(ii) receive and consider the recommendations and advice of the advisory council.]
 - 68 [(b) The board is not obligated to follow the recommendations of the advisory council.]
 - 69 { (a) establish the Advisory Council for the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind and
 - 70 appoint no more than 11 members to the advisory council;
 - 71 { (b) } (ii) make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
 Administrative
 - Rulemaking Act, regarding the operation of the advisory council; and
 - 73 {(e)} (iii) receive and consider the advice and recommendations of the advisory council but is
 - 74 <u>not obligated to follow the recommendations of the advisory council.</u>
 - (b) The advisory council described in Subsection (4)(a) shall include at least:
 - (i) two members who are blind;
 - (ii) two members who are deaf; and
 - (iii) two members who are deafblind or parents of a deafblind child.
 - 75 [(4)] (5) The board shall approve the annual budget and expenditures of the Utah

- 77 (6) (a) On or before the November interim meeting each year, the board shall report to the
- 78 Education Interim Committee on the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind.
 - (b) The report shall be presented verbally and in written form to the Education Interim Committee and shall
- 79 <u>include:</u>
- $\{\frac{a}{a}\}$ <u>(i)</u> a financial report;
- 81 { (b) } (ii) a report on the activities of the superintendent and associate superintendents;
- 82 { (iii) a report on activities to involve parents and constituency and advocacy groups in
- 83 the governance of the school; and
- 84 { (iv) a report on student achievement including:
- 85 (<u>(i)</u>) <u>(A)</u> student academic achievement data, including longitudinal data for both current and
- previous students served by the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind;
- 87 {(ii)} graduation rates; and
- 88 {-(iii)} (C) students exiting the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind and their educational
- 89 placement after exiting the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind.
