Madam Speaker:

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 260**, PEDESTRIANS ON HIGHWAYS, by Representative L. Perry, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 14:*

13       ▶ provides that a pedestrian may not walk ~~{-along-or-}~~ on a freeway or ~~{-a~~  
**limited-access**

14 **highway-}** certain controlled-access highways in an urbanized area except  
during an emergency; and

2. *Page 2, Lines 47 through 48:*

47       (7) A pedestrian may not walk ~~{-along-or-}~~ on [~~a no-access freeway facility~~] a  
freeway or ~~{-a~~

48 **limited-access highway-}** any other controlled-access highway in an urbanized  
area as defined by the current census upon which entrance, exit, and cross traffic is  
controlled in the same manner as on a freeway except during an emergency.
