**H.B. 72      Waste Tire Amendments (*Rep. N. Hendrickson*)**

Rep. Hendrickson introduced the bill, which was amended in an earlier committee meeting, as follows:

*1. Page 7, Lines 187 through 193:*

187           (1) There is created a restricted special revenue fund entitled the "Waste Tire  
                Recycling

188   Fund."

189           (2) The fund shall consist of:

190           (a) the proceeds of the fee imposed under Section 19-6-805; and

191           (b) penalties collected under this part {~~;~~and}

192            {~~(c) assets transferred to and loan repayments deposited in the fund pursuant~~

**MOTION:**    Rep. Cox moved to amend the bill as follows:
