1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:

- 12       ▶     authorizes a student to be charged a per credit hour partial tuition for  
              certain higher  
13     education courses offered in public schools through concurrent enrollment;  
14       ▶     requires that concurrent enrollment courses:  
15       •     {~~meet general education requirements~~} be introductory-level  
              courses at higher education institutions; and

2. *Page 1, Lines 18 through 19:*

18       ▶ requires the State Board of Regents {~~and the State Board of Education to~~  
          **work**  
19    ~~collaboratively to offer~~} **to develop** certain technology-intensive concurrent  
          enrollment courses;

3. *Page 3, Lines 83 through 88:*

83       (4) (a) Concurrent enrollment courses shall be **introductory-level general**  
          **education, career and technical education, or pre-major** college-level courses  
          {~~corresponding to~~  
84    ~~the first or second year of general education~~} at a state institution of higher education  
          leading  
85    toward a certificate or degree.  
86       (b) The State Board of Regents {~~and the State Board of Education~~} shall **:**  
          **(i)** develop  
87    technology-intensive concurrent enrollment courses, designed as hybrid courses, having a  
88    blend of different learning activities available both in classrooms and online **;** **and**

4. *Page 5, Lines 124 through 126:*

124       (ii) **except as provided in Subsection (9)(f),** partial tuition of up to \$30 per  
          credit hour for each concurrent enrollment course for  
125    which the student receives college credit, paid directly to the institution of higher  
          education  
126    that offers the credit.

5. *Page 5, Line 132:*

132    receive credit from an institution of higher education.  
      **(f) A state institution of higher education may not charge tuition to a high**  
      **school concurrent enrollment student for:**  
      **(i) a technology-intensive concurrent enrollment course described in Subsection**  
      **(4)(b); or**  
      **(ii) a gateway career and technology education course, as defined by the State**  
      **Board of Regents.**
