



**MOTION:** Rep. Arent moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 2, Line 28:*

28 alleged violation; ~~{and}~~ =

► provides that a law enforcement agency that receives a report shall issue a warning citation that does not involve a fine, court appearance, or a person's driving record to the registered owner of the vehicle; and

2. *Page 5, Lines 121 through 122:*

121 (3) A law enforcement agency that receives a report in accordance with Subsection

(2) ∴

122 (a) may have a peace officer initiate an investigation of the reported violation ∴ and

(b) shall issue a warning citation that does not involve a fine, court appearance, or a person's driving record to the registered owner of the vehicle .
