**MOTION:** Sen. McAdams moved to approve the minutes of the February 9, 2012 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Romero, Pres. Waddoups and Sen. Weiler absent for the vote.

**S.B. 210 Process Server Amendments** (*Sen. S. Urquhart*)

**MOTION:** Sen. Urquhart moved to amend S.B. 210 as follows:

1. *Page 1, Lines 26 through 27:*

26 (1) Complaints, summonses, {~~supplemental orders, writs of garnishment,~~  
~~garnishee~~  
27 ~~orders, notices.~~} and subpoenas may be served by any person 18 years of age or older  
at the time

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Weiler absent for the vote.
