POSTING OF TRESPASS

Representative **John G. Mathis** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 13:*

13 This bill:

► modifies the definition of "properly posted";

2. *Page 2, Lines 43 through 46:*

43 (d) "Properly posted" means that {~~"No Trespassing"~~} signs prohibiting trespass or {~~a~~
44 minimum of 100 square

inches of} bright yellow, bright orange, or fluorescent paint are clearly displayed :
45 (i) at all corners, fishing

46 streams crossing property lines, roads, gates, and rights-of-way entering the land {~~. If metal~~

fence posts are used, the entire exterior side shall be painted.} ; or
(ii) in a manner that would reasonably be expected to be seen by a person in the area.

3. *Page 3, Lines 59 through 65:*

59 (B) the owner's employee; or

60 (C) a person with apparent authority to act for the owner; or

61 (ii) the land is fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner that a reasonable person
