# AGRICULTURAL OPERATION INTERFERENCE

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Representative **John G. Mathis** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 17:*

- 11 This bill:
- 12 ▶ defines agricultural operation;
- 13 ▶ provides that a person is guilty of agricultural operation interference if the person ~~{,}~~ • records an image of, or sound from, an agricultural operation after receiving notice not to record, and while the person is on the property where the agricultural operation is located; and
- 14 without the consent of the owner of the operation, records an image of, or sound
- 15 from, an agricultural operation ~~{ while on the property where the agricultural~~
- 16 ~~operation is located;}~~ with a device that the person leaves on the property; or
- 17 ▶ establishes penalties.

2. *Page 2, Lines 32 through 37:*

- 32 (2) A person is guilty of agricultural operation interference if the person ~~{,}~~ •
- 33 (a) without
- 34 consent from the owner of the operation, or the owner's agent, knowingly or intentionally
- 35 records an image of, or sound from, the operation ~~{,}~~ by leaving a recording device on the property
- 36 where the agricultural operation is located; or
- 37 (b) knowingly or intentionally records an image of, or sound from, the operation, while the person is on
- 38 the property where the agricultural operation is located, after receiving notice from the owner of the
- 39 operation or the owner's agent that the person may not record an image of, or sound from, the
- 40 operation.
