- 1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 14 House Floor Amendments 3-2-2012:
  - 13 \rightarrow \{\text{requires that 24-hour notice be given before the Executive Appropriations}\}
  - 14 Committee or an appropriations subcommittee adopts intent language; arecommends that intent language be made public 24 hours before being considered or proposed at an Executive Appropriations Committee or an appropriations subcommittee;
- 2. Page 2, Lines 33 through 39 House Floor Amendments 3-2-2012:
  - 33 (3) (a) {The} Where possible, intent language that is to be considered at or proposed for an Executive Appropriations Committee or an appropriations subcommittee
- 34 { may not discuss intent language for inclusion in an appropriations bill unless that intent
  - 35 <u>language</u>, including and the name of the legislator proposing the intent language {, has been} shall be made
  - public at least 24 hours before the meeting.
  - 37 (b) All intent language considered at or proposed for an Executive Appropriations Committee or an appropriations subcommittee shall identify the name of the legislator proposing the intent language.
    - (c) Nothing in { this } Subsection (3) (a) prohibits the Executive Appropriations Committee
  - 38 or an appropriations subcommittee from { further discussion or amendment of intent language
