 - 15 { requires a charter school to comply with Title 52, Chapter 3, Prohibiting
 - 16 Employment of Relatives;
- 2. *Page 4, Lines 88 through 89:*
 - 88 (3) [The following statutes governing public employees and officers do] Chapter 8a,
 - 89 <u>Public Education Human Resource Management Act,</u> <u>and Title 52, Chapter 3, Prohibiting Employment of Relatives,</u> { <u>do</u> not apply to <u>a</u> charter [schools:]
- 3. Page 8, Lines 234 through 236:
 - (1) "Career employee" means an employee of a school district who has obtained a
 - reasonable expectation of continued employment based upon { Section [53A-8-106] 53A-8a-201
 - 236 and an agreement with the employee or the employee's association, district practice, or } policy of a local school board .
- 4. Page 13, Lines 384 through 386:
 - 384 (c) of parents submitted by school community councils within the district.
 - (4) Subject to Subsection (5), the joint committee may:
 - (a) adopt or adapt an evaluation program for teachers based on a model developed by the State Board of Education; or
 - (b) create its own evaluation program for teachers.

 - (1) The State Board of Education shall make rules requiring a school district's

 - 667 (2) Rules adopted under Subsection (1) shall:
 - 668 (a) establish a timeline for developing and implementing an employee compensation
