## Senator Curtis S. Bramble proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 7, Lines 188 through 192:
  - 188 (3) (a) A person filing a complaint for an ethics violation of Title 67, Chapter 16, Utah
  - Public Officers' and Employees' Ethics Act, shall file the complaint with:
  - (i) a local political subdivision ethics commission, if the political subdivision has
  - established a local political subdivision ethics commission under Subsection (1) or (2); or
  - 192 <u>(ii) the commission</u> <u>if the political subdivision has not established a local political subdivision</u> <u>ethics commission</u> .
- 2. Page 35, Lines 1054 through 1059:
  - 1054 (2) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (3), a person filing a complaint for a violation
  - of this part shall file the complaint:
  - (i) with the county ethics commission, if the county has established a county ethics
  - commission in accordance with Subsection (1); or
  - 1058 (ii) with the Political Subdivisions Ethics Review Commission established in
  - 1059 <u>accordance with Title 11, Chapter 49, Political Subdivisions Ethics Review Commission</u> <u>if the county has</u> not established a county ethics commission .
