General Description:
This bill modifies Title 26, Chapter 53, Protection of Athletes with Head Injuries Act,
by clarifying the requirements of a school nurse engaged in treating a student who
sustains a concussion or traumatic head injury.
Highlighted Provisions:
This bill:
▶ permits a school nurse to assess a child who sustains a concussion or traumatic head
injury during school hours on school property; and
 prohibits a school nurse from providing a written statement permitting the child to
return to free play or physical education class after sustaining a concussion or
traumatic head injury unless the nurse has been trained in the evaluation and
management of a head injury.

31	(1) A school nurse may assess a child who is suspected of sustaining a concussion or a
32	traumatic head injury during school hours on school property regardless of whether the nurse
33	has received specialized training in the evaluation and management of a concussion.
34	(2) A school nurse who does not meet the requirements of Subsections
35	26-53-301(1)(b)(i) and (1)(b)(ii)(A), but who assesses a child who is suspected of sustaining a
36	concussion or traumatic head injury under Subsection (1):
37	(a) shall refer the child to a qualified health care provider who is trained in the
38	evaluation and management of a concussion; and
39	(b) may not provide a written statement permitting the child to resume participation in
40	free play or physical education class under Subsection 26-53-301(1)(b)(ii).
41	(3) A school nurse shall undergo training, described in Section 53A-6-112, in the
42	evaluation and management of a concussion, as funding allows.
