Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 75-1-312 is enacted to read:
<u>75-1-312.</u> Alternative resolution of disputes.
(1) A will, trust, or power of attorney may include a provision, enforceable by a court,
that requires the resolution of disputes between or among beneficiaries and fiduciaries of the
will, trust, or power of attorney, or any combination of those persons or entities, outside of a
court of record.
(2) The resolution of disputes outside the court may include any procedure, writing, or

- 30 agreement, not contrary to or prohibited by law, found or referred to in a will, trust, or power of
- 31 attorney, the purpose of which is to resolve disputes between or among the beneficiaries and
- 32 <u>fiduciaries of a will, trust, or power of attorney, or any combination of those persons or entities,</u>
- 33 <u>outside of a court of record.</u>
- 34 (3) Unless terms in a dispute resolution procedure, writing, or agreement require
- 35 <u>binding arbitration, nothing in the writing or agreement shall prevent beneficiaries or</u>
- 36 <u>fiduciaries, upon satisfaction of the required terms of the dispute resolution procedure, writing,</u>
- 37 <u>or agreement, from seeking resolution of unresolved disputes in a court of record.</u>
