53-7-208, as last amended by Laws of Utah 1996, Chapter 198

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53-7-208** is amended to read:

53-7-208. Penalty and punishment.

[(+)] Any person who violates Sections 53-7-206 and 53-7-207, requiring standard equipment, is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.

~~[(2) A violator shall be punished by:]~~



- 28 [~~(a) a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$250;~~]
- 29 [~~(b) imprisonment in the county jail for not less than 10 days, nor more than 60 days;~~
- 30 or]
- 31 [~~(c) both a fine and imprisonment.]~~
